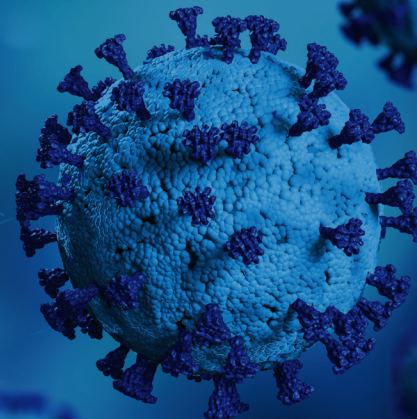


What to Do If Exposed to Someone Confirmed or Suspected to Have COVID-19



UNVACCINATED

Have You Been Vaccinated? NO

Quarantine and get tested immediately. Do not go out until you experience 24 hours with no fever and other symptoms improve.

Did you test positive for COVID-19? NO

Get tested again in 5-7 days after exposure or immediately if symptoms arise. You may have received a false negative result.

Did you test positive for COVID-19? YES

Self-isolate for 5 days. Do not go out until you experience 24 hours with no fever and other symptoms improve. Wear a mask for 5 days after symptoms resolve or improve.

Once recovered, please consider getting vaccinated. It is possible to be reinfected even if you have had COVID-19. If you were treated with monoclonal antibodies or convalescent plasma, wait 90 days before vaccination.

VACCINATED

Have You Been Fully Vaccinated? YES

Wait 3-5 days after exposure to be tested. Wear a mask until you receive a negative result.

Did you test positive for COVID-19? YES

Stay home for 5 days after receiving your results. If asymptomatic or symptoms resolving (no fever for 24 hours), follow that by wearing a mask around others for 5 days.

Did you test positive for COVID-19? NO

Great news! Get tested again in 5-7 days after exposure or immediately if symptoms arise. If you are eligible and have not gotten your booster yet, please schedule an appointment today.
